Dear Parents,

It is time again to begin the registration process for the 2018-19 P.S.R. school year for all students.

- Begin by reading through the Fact Sheet at the end of this letter. It will answer most if not all of your questions. **Fees for the school year are \$70 for one, \$140 for two, and \$ 165 for 3 or more students.**
- **You can do a complete registration and fee payment online in just a few minutes!** Simply go to [www.saintedwards.org](http://www.saintedwards.org), click on the *Faith Formation* tab at the top of the screen, and then click on the *PSR* tab. Click on the *2018-19 PSR online registration* tab and follow the instructions. You can register up to 4 children at once.
- If you wish to pay the registration fees on line, go back to the web site home page and click on the green *On-Line Giving* tab further down the page . If you already have an account established (e.g. for parish contributions), you can also select *PSR Registration Fees*. If you don't already have an account, it takes just minutes to establish one by following the directions. **We hope you will take advantage of this option again, but you can also mail in or drop off your fee payments.**
- The "paper registration forms" are also under the *PSR* tab. They are in a pdf. Format and are titled as: *New or Returning to PSR* and *Grades 1-4 class preference form*. Print them, complete by hand and either mail or drop off at our office along with a check or cash for registration fees. We also have forms in the office if you stop by.

Calendars for the entire 2018-19 school year will be made available later this summer and can be accessed on the website. As always, we will produce separate calendars for those attending Wednesday classes, and for those attending Sunday classes, as well as the TAG and EDGE programs (see fact sheet). **We will continue to use e-mail extensively to notify parents throughout the year of calendar and schedule items.**

## P.S.R. 2018-19 School Year - Fact Sheet

### Grades Pre-K (4 year olds) & Kindergarten

- We will continue to combine both groups of students into one class, which will continue to be held Sunday mornings during the 10:45 a.m. Mass. **The first class date is Sunday, September 16.**

### Grades 1, 2, 3 & 4

- Classes will continue on Wednesday evenings with the usual option to choose a class period preference:  
**Grades 1, 2, 3 & 4 - Class time from 5:15 to 6:15 p.m.**  
**BREAK - 6:15 to 6:30 p.m.**  
**Grades 1, 2, 3 & 4 - Class time from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m.**
- The class-period preference for your child (or children) will be honored on a “first come-first served” basis. You may assume your choice has been accepted unless you hear otherwise from our office. **The first class date is Wednesday, September 12. There will be a short Opening Assembly for everyone (including parents) in the Parish Hall at the beginning of each set of classes. One assembly at 5:15 p.m. and one assembly at 6:30 p.m.**
- Parents of 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade students will receive separate mailings after the school year begins which provides all of the important activities and calendar dates regarding preparation for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist.
- **We are pleased to begin a third year of our “TAG” (Tweens and God) program for our 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade students.** With direction from our Youth Minister, Marissa Everhart, these students as a single group will spend several class periods spaced throughout the school year in activities designed to build upon their experience of First Eucharist (from 2<sup>nd</sup> grade). They will experience a fun and faith-filled community environment that helps them develop a life of personal prayer and prepares them for their eventual transition to middle school years. **There will be more information released regarding the TAG calendar as the school year begins.**

### Grades 5, 6, 7 & 8

- Classes will continue to be held on Sunday mornings from 9:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. **The first class date is Sunday, September 16. There will be a short Opening Assembly for everyone (including parents) in the Parish Hall at 9:30 a.m.**
- Parents of 8<sup>th</sup> Grade students will receive separate mailings after the school year begins which provides all of the important calendar dates regarding preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

- **We are also please to begin the third year of “EDGE” program for our 5<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> grade students** Also with direction from our Youth Minister, Marissa Schlabach, these students will spend several class periods throughout the school year as a single group in activities that build faith-filled bonds with one another and allow them to bring up and share faith questions. It will also help them in their spiritual maturation process in an honest and caring way. Deepening one’s faith during these critical middle school years will help them make the transition to preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation in 8<sup>th</sup> Grade. **There will be more information released regarding the EDGE calendar as the school year begins.**

### **Limited Home-School Option**

- Homeschooling does not apply to any student preparing for Sacraments in grades 2 and 8, and also generally for students in grade 7. **Parent(s) who are considering this must make an appointment to meet with me to discuss the necessity of home-schooling and receive approval.** Completion of a registration form and payment of fees is still required.
